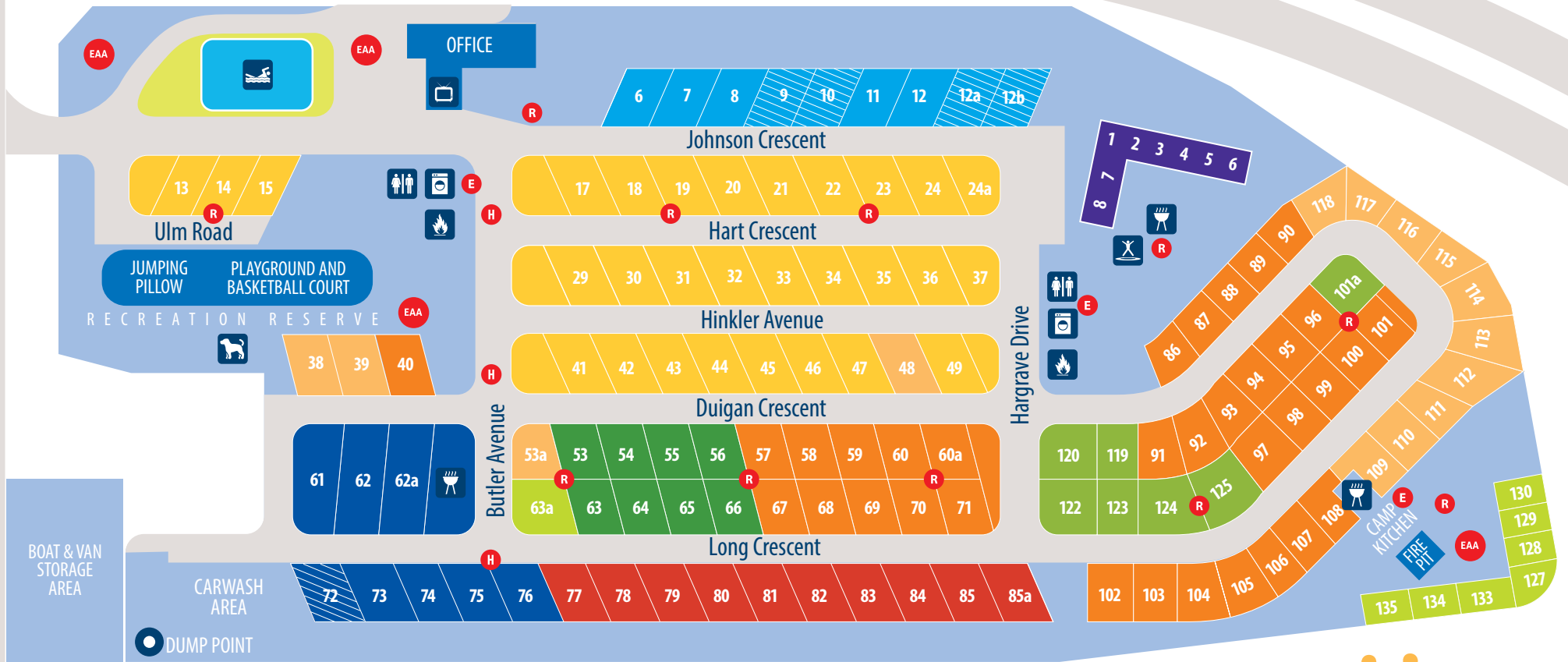

# PARK RULES

## ☺ SITES

Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharging of sullage water and disposing of rubbish.

## ☺ GARBAGE

Receptacles are located throughout the Park for your convenience. Please assist by wrapping all garbage prior to its disposal.

## ☺ FEES

Please make sure all fees are paid in advance.

## ☺ CHECK-IN/OUT

Site fees are calculated until 10am on the day of departure. If your travel arrangements are inconvenienced by these times, please contact reception to make alternative arrangements. Villa/cabin check-in is 2pm. Ensuite check-in is 11am. Site check-in is 10am.

## ☺ VEHICLES

The safety of all guests is of prime importance. You can assist by limiting the speed of your vehicle to 10 kilometres (walking pace) while within the Park. Please contact reception if you wish to wash or repair your vehicle on site.

## ☺ SECURITY GATE

To assist in security and safety whilst staying at the Park please do not share the security gate code with other people. The gate shuts at 7.00pm and reopens at 7.00am. Please ensure you have your code. The code is refreshed every Monday at 12 noon. See reception for new code.

## ☺ SECURE YOUR SITE

Ensure you secure items of value at all times. You are advised to lock the door to your accommodation before retiring each night; as you would in your own home.

## ☺ FIRE PIT

Children must be supervised at all times and the area must be vacated at 10pm. No other solid fuel fires are permitted in the park.

## ☺ SWIMMING POOL

The pool is open for your enjoyment from 8am until dusk. The pool is NOT supervised by Park Staff. The safety of children using the pool is the responsibility of their carer at all times. Toddlers are to be in swimmer nappies. Use of swimming pools and associated facilities may result in serious personal injury including death, drowning, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Flips, somersaults and inverted manoeuvres into the water are dangerous and prohibited. Other risks include diving head first, slips, trips, falls, running on wet surfaces and not providing adequate supervision to children.

## ☺ TELEPHONE MESSAGES

Messages will be delivered to your site/cabin.

## ☺ JUMPING PILLOW/TRAMPOLINE

Use of jumping pillows and trampolines may result in serious personal injury including death, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Flips, somersaults and inverted manoeuvres are dangerous and prohibited. Other risks include falls and collisions with other users. Not to be used when wet.

## ☺ PLAYGROUND

Use of playground equipment may result in serious personal injury including death, head, eye or spinal injury, paralysis, broken limbs or strains. Risks include falls and collisions with other users and hazards associated with gaps, openings and protruding objects.

## ☺ PET FRIENDLY

Pets must be contained within your site and on a leash at all times within the park bounds. There is a leash free area located near the jumping pillow and is open 24 hours. Pets are not to be left unattended in the park at any time.

## ☺ NOISE

The peaceful enjoyment of our Park and its facilities by all our guests/visitors is important to us. Please be considerate to your neighbours by restricting noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings – particularly between 10pm and 8am. Zero tolerance exists for noise complaints after 10pm.

## ☺ AMENITIES

Hot water is available for showers, washing machines and basins. Please consider others and limit the time spent in showers. Water is a precious resource, please watch every drop.

## ☺ CHILDREN

The Park and its facilities are provided for the enjoyment of all guests/visitors. The supervision of children is vital for their safety and will also make sure they do not disturb other people in the Park. Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the amenities and using the playground, jumping pillow and swimming pool.

## ☺ SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER-SKATES AND ROLLER BLADES

The reception can provide information on the nearest safe area for children to use skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades etc. For the safety of all guest/visitors these items are not to be used within the Park grounds.

## ☺ BICYCLES, SCOOTERS

Bicycles/scooters must be ridden on the roads within the Park and no more than 10 kilometres per hour during daylight hours only. Please ensure children are aware of these safety requirements and that they wear a safety helmet at all times.

## ☺ RECEPTION

Reception is open from 7.30am to 7.30pm, seven days a week.
